Tip of the Month

When extending the legs of your tripod, extend from the top (thickest legs) down to the bottom (thinnest legs). To get the most stability only extend as many sections as needed. To add additional stability, most tripods have a hook on the bottom of the center shaft which you can use to attach a heavy object, such as a backpack.
