Post-Processing to Make Your Images Sing!

Lisa is an award-winning Pittsburgh-based photographer specializing in capturing the poetry of nature. For this meeting, Lisa will discuss the importance of simple post processing adjustments you can apply to your photos to really make them sing. Many of these adjustments can be made on a cell phone, and are a staple of Lightroom and Photoshop. This session will be interactive as Lisa would like audience participation and input. Her goal is to encourage participants to consider how they can apply these techniques to their own images.
